On Saturday, 11 May, 2019, we're inviting you to join us for our fabulous bus tour to Donaueschingen and to the Elevator Test Tower in Rottweil.

Come with us on a day combining legends, history, and modern technology. **Donaueschingen**, known for the **Danube Source**, its **Art Nouveau** buildings, the **Fürstenberg** Brewery and more, is well worth a visit by itself.

On top of it all, on our way back, we will stop at the **ThyssenKrupp Elevator Test Tower** near Rottweil. We'll have a guided tour around and to the top of the Tower with its highest public visitor platform in Germany (232 mtrs). This is a special event, however, **members** only pay **35 €** per person for the whole day; **non-members** pay **45 €** per person. The amount per person includes: Bus inkl. parking fees, guided city tours, all tips, guided tours of and entrance to the Test Tower. Lunch and other personal expenses are on the individual.

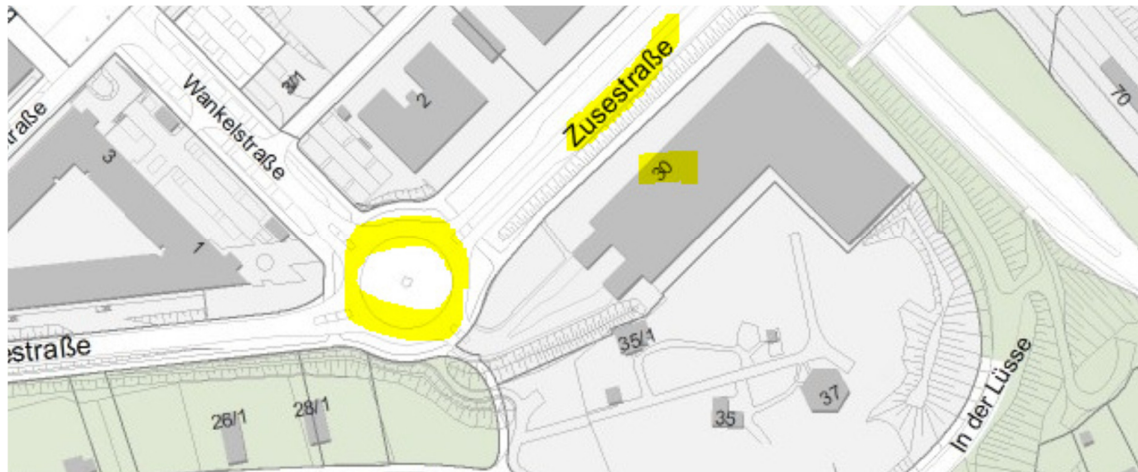

By car:

Oesterfeld P+R ☿ Circle = Meeting Point with our Bus – ATTENTION! The Park and Ride parking garage is no longer free on weekends. The parking ticket is also a VVS public trans. ticket. Choose a ticket for one person for 4-24 hours parking time. It will cost €8.

Navigation address: P+R Parkhaus Oesterfeld, Zusestrasse 30, 70563 Stuttgart-Vaihingen. The street sign does not say "Oesterfeld" but only „P+R“, so please use „Zusestrasse 30“ in Stuttgart-Vaihingen.

By Public Transport:

S-Bahn: S1/S2 from Vaihingen Bahnhof direction Stadtmitte or from Stuttgart Hauptbahnhof direction Ostfildern/Herrnberg. **Stop: Oesterfeld.** Walk upstairs/uphill to the Park and Ride and the meeting point.
