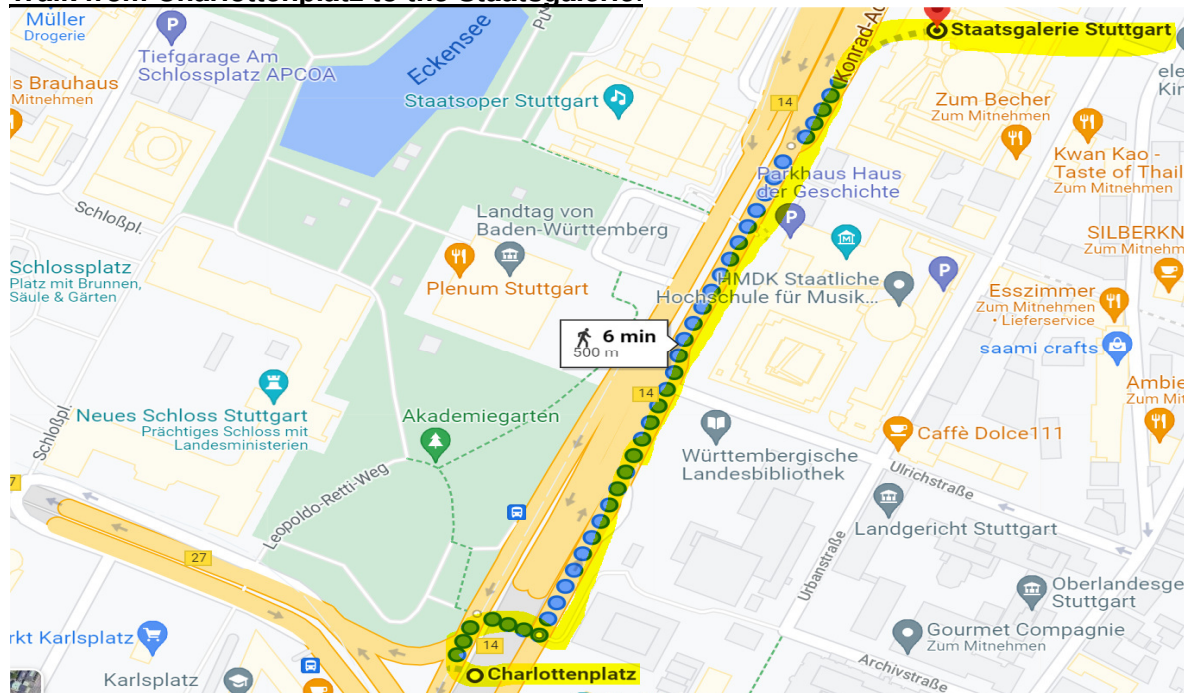
Please note: Events and dates are subject to change! If you would like more information on any of these events, or would like to sign up in advance, please talk to any Board member.

Directions to the Staatsgalerie, Konrad-Adenauer-Straße 30-32, 70173 Stuttgart.

By car: Multi-story car parks: Staatsgalerie, Haus der Geschichte, Landtag, Schlossgarten, or Landesbibliothek. For more information on parking, go to www.pbw.de. In view of the high density of traffic, the large Stuttgart 21 construction site, and the limited available parking, we recommend coming by public transport.

By public transport: Our recommendation is to take one of the following Stadtbahn trains **U2, U4, U5, U6, U7, U12, U14, U15** to “**Charlottenplatz**” and then walk over to the Staatsgalerie Stuttgart (about an 8 minutes’ walk), please see below sketch:
