

We would like to invite you to join us on
Saturday, March 21, 2026 at 14:30 in the
Veitskapelle Stuttgart-Mühlhausen, the oldest Church in Stuttgart.

The Protestant St. Vitus Chapel in Stuttgart-Mühlhausen is one of the most important gems of Gothic architecture in the Stuttgart region. The church is named after the national saint of Bohemia, St. Vitus. **Masters of the Prague cathedral building workshop built the church beginning from the year 1380.** Fresco painters painted the church with biblical themes and scenes from the life of St. Vitus. These beautiful frescoes are largely intact and represent the most complete set of original medieval church fresco paintings in this area of Germany. The original high altar of St. Vitus' Chapel is in the Staatsgalerie Stuttgart. In its place is a winged altar created around 1510, with St. Vitus as the main figure. Under the canopies, carved altars depict the figures of Peter, Paul and John as well as the martyrs Dorothea, Katharina, Walpurga, Barbara and Agathe. Also worthy of note are the tombs of the local nobility.

We will meet at 14:30 at the North or upper gate in the Church Wall (right side of the picture). Our one-hour tour in English starts at 15:00. After the tour we will have a little time to explore the church on our own before we walk downhill on the Veitstraße, crossing the Mönchfeldstraße and on to the Arnoldstraße to the restaurant **Gasthaus RÖSSLE, Arnoldstraße 3, 70378 Stuttgart-Mühlhausen**, where we will enjoy a nice meal together (see map on back).

Cost: **5 € for members, 10 € for non-members** - collected on site. All monies collected will be donated to the Veitskapelle Mühlhausen.



Driving directions: Address, Veitskapelle, Meierberg 16, 70370 Stuttgart. There is limited parking around the church. More parking near the restaurant in the Arnoldstraße or the Revalerstraße, or at the Bürgerbüro, Mühlhausen (see map below).

We recommend Public Transportation: U12 from Dürrolewang, Direction Neckargröningen/Remseck, through the Stuttgart Main Train Station and on to the Haltestelle Mühlhausen, - or -

U14 from Vaihingen, direction Mühlhausen, through Charlottenplatz and on to Mühlhausen (last stop).
