We invite you to join us on **Saturday, October 10, 2026** for a visit to the **Eselsmühle (donkey mill)**, romantically situated in the Siebenmühlental near Leinfelden-Echterdingen.

Located in the Reichenbachtal near Leinfelden-Echterdingen, the **Siebenmühlental (Seven Mills Valley)** was first mentioned in 1383. Over the course of the next centuries, up to 11 grain mills were operated in the valley by water power and often with the help of donkeys (Esel).

The **Eselsmühle** was first mentioned in 1451 and was the last mill in the valley to mill grain until 2007. Today, the Eselsmühle is a very popular destination to buy their organic bread (baked in their own wood-fired ovens) and other organic goods, visit their shop or have a meal / coffee and cake in their lovely restaurant / café. The Eselsmühle is under monument protection and is operated by the same family since 1937. Among other things, we will visit their bake house and hear about the history past / present.

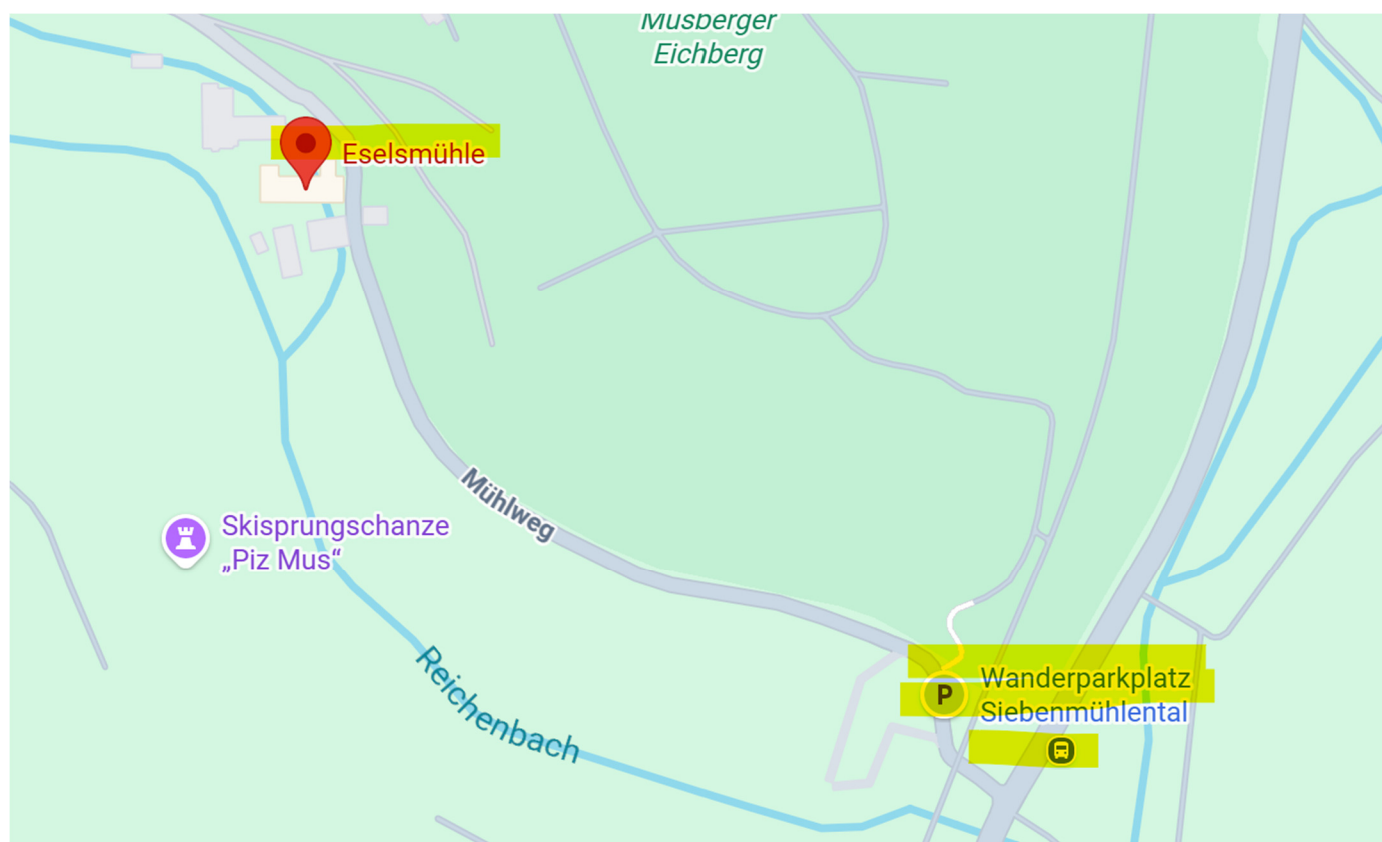
